Dominion Energy Riverrock announces music lineup for 2018 festival

The Wood Brothers and The Marcus King Band to headline

RICHMOND, VA – <u>Dominion Energy Riverrock</u> announced today the full list of music acts performing at this year's festival. On Friday, May 18th, <u>The Marcus King Band</u> will take the stage at 8:00 p.m. On Saturday, May 19th, <u>The Wood Brothers</u> will be the headliner, also taking the stage at 8:00 p.m. The outdoor sports and music festival, celebrating its 10th anniversary, will be held on Brown's Island and Historic Tredegar in Richmond, Virginia, May 18-20, 2018.



Touring in support of the newly-released 'One Drop of Truth,' their sixth studio album, The Wood Brothers relied on artistic expression to produce one of their most dynamic recordings yet. The trio, made up of brothers Oliver and Chris Wood, along with Jano Rix, put faith in themselves and ultimately their audience by writing and recording a collection of songs that is honest and pure. After touring extensively in support of the 2015 album 'Paradise,' the band, based in Nashville, took a fresh approach to recording and mixing on 'One Drop of Truth,' resulting in a deep wellspring of sounds, styles, and influences.

Led by 21-year-old Marcus King, The Marcus King Band is quickly becoming one of the country's most soughtafter live acts. King shows his musical ability throughout 'The Marcus King Band,' his second full-length album, and the fiery blend of American roots music showcases his gorgeous vocals, soaring guitar work, and heartfelt songwriting that blends perfectly with his group of masterful musicians. The Marcus King Band features Jack Ryan on drums and percussion, Stephen Campbell on bass, Dean Mitchell on saxophone, and Justin Johnson on trumpet, trombone, and backing vocals, and the band's energy is never more evident than during its blazing live shows.
