## Dominion Energy Riverrock to feature 'Dandelion Wishes' public art installation

## Public invited to participate in project May 15 and May 16 at Rocketts Landing

RICHMOND, VA — To celebrate the vibrant art community in Richmond and encourage festival participants to take part in the creative process, <u>Dominion Energy Riverrock</u> is partnering with Richmond-based artists <u>Kevin and Andrea Orlosky</u> for the Dandelion Wishes art installation. The project will take place at Rocketts Landing on Saturday, May 15, from 10 a.m. — 3 p.m. and Sunday, May 16, from 10 a.m. — 2 p.m. Members of the public are invited to assist in the creation of the installation during the festival.

Dandelion Wishes will enliven a small field adjacent to the Virginia Capital Trail and Intermediate Terminal at Rocketts Landing with a whimsical, kinetic installation that engages participants to create dandelion seeds using bicycle tires. Referencing the Virginia Capital Trail which runs along the site, and the outdoor adventure focus of Dominion Energy Riverrock, the dandelion seeds are easy to assemble from painted sections of used tires and will sway in the breeze. Participants are encouraged to write a wish on the dandelion seed, before planting it in the field. The project accommodates up to 100 dandelion wishes, which will create a field that breathes new life into our hopes and aspirations as a community.

"I believe public art is an important part of society. Our artworks often explore the concept of connectivity, building depth in collective understanding and amplifying unique details specific to a community," said Orlosky, who created the Dandelion Wishes concept and is coordinating the project for Dominion Energy Riverrock. "The James River and outdoor life holds a lot of identity in Richmond. It's a natural fit for subject matter when doing projects in this community. I hope Dandelion Wishes conveys a positive message in several different ways, by building an immersive environment portraying hope and resilience and illustrating our commonalities and shared values."

"Dominion Energy Riverrock places a strong emphasis on public art and its connection with outdoor exploration and adventure," said Stephen Lecky, Director of Events for Venture Richmond Events, which organizes Dominion Energy Riverrock in partnership with Sports Backers. "We are excited to introduce Dandelion Wishes as part of this year's festival, and it's great to collaborate with Kevin and Andrea Orlosky and the local art community to highlight the amazing work being created in Richmond."
